

QUITMAN COUNTY TAX NOTICE



There are rumors circulating that all deadlines for tax payments have been extended. While this is true of income tax and maybe some other taxes, it is not a true statement about property taxes. The 2019 property taxes which are paid at the Quitman County Tax Collector's office are due now and the last day to pay these taxes is Monday, April 6th, 2020. Mrs. Alice Smith, the Tax Collector, stated that the Mississippi Department of Revenue did not extend the 2019 tax payment deadline. Mrs. Smith also stated that she plans to have the 2019 tax sale of unpaid properties on the afternoon of April 6th, 2020.

Concerning past due taxes from 2017 tax year, Chancery Clerk Butch Scipper stated that the last day to redeem the 2017 property taxes is on Thursday, April 2nd, 2020, which is two full years since the sale of those taxes. Any property that is not redeemed by that date may become the property of the investor. The list of properties with outstanding tax debt has been run in the Quitman County Democrat in recent weeks.
